By way of present petition, the counsel for the petitioner seeks issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 for a comprehensive re-investigation in FIR No.67 dated 01.04.2024, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 341, 452 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh. A further prayer is also made to initiate appropriate legal action on the representations dated 06.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) and 02.05.2024 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the son of the petitioner was given beatings by the accused persons named in the present petition and that pursuant to the registration of abovementioned FIR, the accused persons are threatening the petitioner's son and recently also, they have inflicted injuries to the son of the petitioner. He further submits that despite submission of abovementioned representations before the concerned Police Authorities, no action has been taken into the matter so far. He further submits

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that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh is directed to look into the matter and take prompt and appropriate decision in accordance with law on the representations dated 06.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) and 02.05.2024 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner.

There is no representation on behalf of the respondent-U.T. Chandigarh, however, considering the order which this Court proposes to pass, the service upon the respondents is hereby dispensed with at this stage.

Taking into consideration the allegations levelled and the alleged conduct of the private respondents, who are allegedly extending threats to the son of the petitioner, who is currently a witness of the State in FIR No.67 dated 01.04.2024 (supra), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh to examine the representations dated 06.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) and 02.05.2024 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner and, if need be, issue appropriate directions while taking a prompt decision thereupon, in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
