1. On the last date of hearing i.e. 11.01.2024, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has not joined the investigation, despite repeated calls by the Investigating Officer.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer at 10.00 am on 18.01.2024 to join the investigation and also on all such dates, as and when required by the Investigating Officer. She is also directed to fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer.

List on 08.02.2024.

In case, the petitioner does not join the investigation, the petition shall be dismissed only on this ground.

Interim order to continue.”

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh,

submits that the police officials had affixed notice outside the residence of the petitioner and she was directed to join the investigation. Apart from that, the police officials had gone to her house to direct her to join the investigation, but she was not found. Even otherwise, in spite of repeated orders by this Court, the petitioner has not joined the investigation in the present case.

3. Consequently, the present petition is ordered to be dismissed.
