



Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-2) in FIR bearing No.156 dated 10.09.2022 under Sections 452/427/324/148/149 of IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 16.04.2024 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion for 27.05.2024.

At this stage, on the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State and Mr. Vikas Gupta, Advocate accepts notice for respondent No.2 and files his power of attorney and admits to the factum of compromise. Copy of the paper book be supplied to them during the course of day.

Service is complete.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within two weeks from today or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to get their statements recorded regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed i.e. 27.05.2024.

A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance.

To be heard along with CRM-M-23281-2024.”

3. In compliance of the above order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by



the Hon’ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466, Ramgopal and another Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh 2021 SCC OnLine SC 834 and Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63 and Full Bench of this Court in Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, this petition is allowed and DDR No.22 dated 20.11.2022 registered under Sections 451/354/427/506/148/149 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-2) in FIR bearing No.156 dated 10.09.2022 under Sections 452/427/324/148/149 of IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran (Annexue P-1) and compromise dated 16.04.2024, all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioners.
