HARPREET SINGH BRAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Present revision petition has been filed for enhancement of the amount of maintenance awarded to the petitioners, vide impugned order dated 10.05.2022 passed by learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Kaithal, whereby application filed under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 was allowed and maintenance of Rs.4,000/- per month was awarded to be paid to petitioner No.1 and Rs.2.500/- per month was awarded to petitioner No.2.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent, at the very outset, submits that present petition has been rendered infructuous, as petitioner No.1 and

the respondent have amicably resolved their dispute and even they approached learned Family Court by filing a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 seeking dissolution of marriage by way of mutual consent, in which statements of the parties at first motion have been recorded.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
