After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to approach the higher authorities against the impugned order dated 14.03.2024 (Annexure P-12), hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to approach the higher authorities and the respondents be directed to decide the said claim in a time bound manner so that petitioner does not suffer prejudice.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any grievance is raised qua the impugned order before the higher authorities, appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to approach the higher authorities.
