HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that some of the benefits, which were sought in the present writ petition, have already been given to the petitioner such as gratuity and for the remaining benefits such as leave encashment, the petitioner has already submitted a legal notice dated 09.04.2021 (Annexure P-3), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the legal notice dated 09.04.2021 (Annexure P-3) has been received in the



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office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. Civil miscellaneous application pending if any, also stands disposed of.
