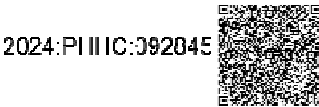
KIRTI SINGH, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to ensure the freedom of life and liberty of the petitioner as the petitioner apprehends her life and liberty in danger at the hands of respondents No.3 to 5.

2. Vide order dated 09.05.2024, learned State counsel had been directed to file reply.

3. Today, reply dated 22.07.2024 has been filed by the learned State counsel in Court. The same is taken on record.

4. As per para No.4 of the said reply, it is stated that the inquiry officer joined both the parties in the inquiry. The petitioner-Sarbjit Kaur has suffered her statement and during the inquiry, it was found that property in dispute comes under the jurisdiction of Police Station Koom Kalan, Ludhiana. Therefore, the complaint was consigned with a direction to respondent No.4 that he may move a complaint before the SHO, Police



5. In view of above, the petitioner may avail alternate remedy in accordance with law and no further order is required to be passed in the present petition.
6. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
