The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to set aside the order dated and order dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar, whereby, the evidence was closed by the Court and the application under Section 311 Cr.P.C. was ordered to be dismissed.
2. Learned State counsel submits that in the present case the petitioner and other co-accused persons had filed a petition for quashing of the FIR in the present case and the said petition has been allowed.
3. As a consequence, the FIR No.133 dated 26.07.2015, under Sections 452, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings have been ordered to be quashed by this Court.
4. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.
