ANIL KSHETARPAL, J(Oral)

1. In this revision petition, the petitioner challenges the correctness of the interim order passed by the Family Court granting maintenance at the rate of Rs.7,000/- per month to the minor child.
2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that in an application filed under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, the child cannot be granted maintenance.
3. This Court has considered the submissions of the learned counsel representing the parties.
4. At the relevant time, the child was only two years old. He was living with the mother, who had filed application for grant of maintenance. While awarding maintenance to the mother, the Court had noticed that the child is staying with the mother, hence, the Court ordered maintenance for the child to ease the difficulty of the mother as otherwise the mother would have to initiate independent proceedings for maintenance on behalf of the child.
5. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.
6. Dismissed accordingly.
