The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.87 dated 17.04.2024 under Sections 61(1)(A) of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Haryana Amendment Bill, 2020), registered at Police Station Sadar Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 09.05.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
