The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.22, dated 05.02.2024, under Sections 272,273,420,467,468,471,120-B of IPC and under Section 61(1) (c),72-A of the Punjab Excise Act,1914 (Haryana Amendment Bill, 2020) (Section 201 of IPC and 63A of Excise Act added later on, registered at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari, Haryana.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders dated 13.05.2024 and 20.11.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim orders dated 13.05.2024 and 20.11.2024 are made absolute.
