This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondents No. 4 and 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

2. Heard.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that feeling aggrieved by the acts and conduct of the private respondents No. 4 and 5, the petitioner had been moving representations to the competent authorities, the latest being Annexure P-5 dated 04.05.2024 moved to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, but no action has been taken on the said representation(s). She further submits that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3 to consider and

dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the aforesaid representation will be decided in accordance with the law.
7. In the circumstances of the case and the submission made thereof, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 04.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) and, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, to dispose of the same expeditiously under the provisions of the law.
8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
9. Disposed of.
