MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

2. In compliance of order dated 10.05.2024 of this Court, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Daljeet Singh, has informed the Court that statements of both the petitioners have since been recorded and they have made a categorical statement that they do not apprehend any threat at the hands of the private respondents, and thus, they do not require any protection. Learned State counsel has also informed the Court that the statements of the private respondents have

also been recorded on 11.05.2024, wherein they too have stated that they are not averse to the live-in relationship of the petitioners.

3. In the light of the categoric statements made by both the parties, no further directions are called for in the instant petition which accordingly stands disposed of.
