1. By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for grant of emergency parole for six weeks in accordance with Section 3(1)(aa) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 and Amendment Act, 2015, as the wife of the petitioner, namely, Ravinder Kaur is seriously ill.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Deputy Commissioner, Tarn Taran informs that prayer made by the petitioner stands accorded followed by release warrants issued in his favour on 16.05.2024 by the District Magistrate, Tarn Taran and the petitioner would be released, subject to his furnishing adequate bail/surety bonds.
