By way of present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought directions to the respondents No.1 to 4 to transfer the investigation of FIR No.56 dated 27.01.2024 registered under Section 346 IPC, P.S. Shivaji Colony, Rohtak (Annexure P-1) to Central Bureau of Investigation.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that feeling aggrieved by the act and conduct of the private respondents, the petitioner who happens to be the complainant in case FIR bearing No.56 dated 27.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) had moved a representation to the police authorities including representation dated 30.04.2024 (Annexure P-8) to Director General of Police, Haryana-respondent No.2 but till date no action thereon has been taken.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate

directions are issued to respondent No.2 to 4 to dispose of the aforesaid representation Annexure P-8 (supra) in accordance with rules in an expeditious manner and to protect the life and liberty of the applicant-petitioner.

- 4. Notice of motion to respondents No.2 to 4.
- 5. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent and submits that the representation (Annexure P-8) will be dealt with in accordance with rules in an expeditious manner by the concerned authorities.
- 6. After hearing the respective submissions by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case thereof, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2- Director General of Police, Haryana to consider the averments made in the representation dated 30.04.2024 (Annexure P-8) and dispose of the same in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner and appropriate steps as required be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner in accordance with law.
- 7. Decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
- 8. Disposed of.
