1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.4 who is harassing him by calling the petitioner to police station and assaulted him physically and mentally.

2. Learned counsel submits that official respondent No.4 has been unnecessarily harassing him by calling him to the police station repeatedly in connection with an abandoned truck which was found on the Chandigarh-Zirakpur Road. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is in no way connected with the said abandoned truck. In the said regard, a representation dated 05.05.2024 was also given to respondent No.-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali). Learned counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali, to look into his



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representation dated 05.05.2024 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate steps at the earliest in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) to look into the representation dated 05.05.2024 (Annexure P-4), in accordance with law.
