1. By way of present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.3 to 5 to conduct a fair and proper investigation by recording statements of petitioner.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the official respondents to decide the complaint/representation dated 27.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) moved at the instance of petitioner by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

3. Prayer seems to be justified.

4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Athar Ahmad, DAG, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

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5. In view of the aforesaid, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, to look into the complaint/representation dated 27.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
