ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

The petitioner herein is a tenant and an application seeking his eviction was filed by the landlord in which the parties settled their dispute. A consent order was passed by the Rent Controller on 17.5.2023, wherein the petitioner undertook to hand over the vacant possession of rented premises to the landlord by 31.12.2023. However, he did not vacate the same, forcing the respondent to file the execution petition.

An application for extending the period to vacate the rented premises was filed, which has been dismissed. The correctness of this order is challenged in this revision petition. Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner is making efforts to find an alternative accommodation, however, he is unable to get the same. This Court has considered this submission.

A consent order was passed on 17.5.2023. Nearly one year has elapsed.

In view of the aforesaid, no ground is made out to interfere in the consent order. Present petition is hereby dismissed.
