This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 10.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioners, feeling aggrieved from the acts and conduct of private respondents No. 4 to 10 had moved a representation dated 07.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal, District Kaithal, but till date no action thereon has been taken. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2 to

consider and dispose of the representation dated 07.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3 and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.
5. After considering the rival contentions and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2- the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal, District Kaithal, to consider and dispose of the representation 07.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.
6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioners.
