2. Learned State counsel has placed on record the custody certificate by pointing out the criminal antecedents of the petitioner, showing that he is involved in as many as 08 other cases and also convicted in 02 cases.

3. At the same time, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harbans Singh, informs that out of 27 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 25 have already been examined.

4. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this Court is not inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner. However, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to make every possible endeavour to expedite the trial.
