**AMARJOT BHATTI, J.**

1. Petitioner Harpreet Singh @Harjeet @Baba has filed petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 66 dated 26.08.2023 under Sections 22 and 29 of Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

2. As per facts of case, police party headed by Sub Inspector was present near T-point Bhulechak Colony, when they spotted one motorcycle coming from the side of Tibber road on which two young boys were sitting. On seeing police party, they got confused and person who was pillion rider took out something from his right pocket wrapped in polythene bag and threw it on the ground. They were apprehended on the basis of suspicion.

Motorcyclist disclosed his name as Sarabjit Masih @Banti and pillion rider

disclosed his name as Dalbir Masih @Parlu @Raju. The motorcycle was taken into police possession and from the said polythene bag, 5 grams of Heroin was recovered. On the basis of this recovery, present FIR was registered. Present petitioner was named by co-accused.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner pointed out that he has already joined the investigation as per order dated 15.05.2024 and he is not required for any other purpose.

4. Learned counsel representing the State confirmed that he was named by co-accused and he has joined the investigation. It is further stated that he is not involved in any other case.

5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, *interim* bail already granted in favour of petitioner – Harpreet Singh @Harjeet @Baba vide order dated 15.05.2024 stands confirmed, subject to conditions mentioned under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition is accordingly allowed.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
