1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents, who are threatening the petitioner to kill him in case he demanded his amount of Rs.7 lakhs back from them.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to look into his representation dated 26.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate steps at the earliest in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to

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respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the representation dated 26.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate steps, if any required, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, in accordance with law.
