MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a roving writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus, directing respondents No.2 to 4 to get released the detainee forthwith from the illegal custody of the private respondents.

2. In compliance of order dated 08.05.2024 of this Court, report has been received from learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur, a perusal of which shows that the alleged detainee made a statement to the effect that she is living with her parents and other relatives at village Nizamwala, voluntarily, out of her own sweet will and has not been detained forcibly by anyone. She further denied any relationship with the petitioner.

3. To the similar effect is the status report filed today in the Court by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Sukhwinder Singh, PPS, DSP (City) Ferozepur, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions and a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel opposite.
4. In the circumstances, nothing survives in the instant petition which accordingly stands disposed of.
