1. By way of present petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 10/11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent on account of alleged non-compliance of order dated 10.02.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-2481-2022.

2. In response, learned Senior counsel representing the respondent submits that the aforementioned order dated 10.02.2022, has been complied with by the respondent by passing a speaking order dated 23.08.2024.

He further submits that even a cost of Rs.10,000/- has already been deposited by the respondent with the Punjab & Haryana High Court

Employee’s Welfare Association, vide receipt No.1138 dated 27.08.2024, in terms of order dated 22.04.2024, passed in the present petition.

3. In view of the above, no cause survives in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the speaking order dated 23.08.2024 in accordance with law. Rule stands discharged.
