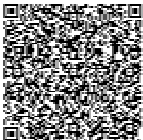

1. The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus*, directing the respondents to issue appointment letter to the petitioner under the reserved category of physically disabled persons (70% handicapped), for the post of TGT (Hindi), being fully eligible.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before respondent No.4. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.4 is directed to decide her pending legal notice, dated 01.04.2024, Annexure P-11, in a specified period.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms.Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice and submits that the pending legal notice will be decided by respondent No.4 expeditiously.
5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the

petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 - Chief Executive



Officer, Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam, to consider and decide the pending legal notice, dated 01.04.2024, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of two months from receiving a certified copy of this order.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹25,000 to the petitioner.
