1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to register a FIR under Section 306 of IPC against the private respondents.
2. Learned State counsel submits that in the present case, one FIR No. 243 dated 20.08.2021, under Section 306 of IPC, Police Station City Faridkot has already been registered against Baba Baldev Singh-respondent No.6. He further submits that during the course of investigation, respondents No.7 and 8 have been found to be innocent and respondents No.9 and 10 have expired. Learned State counsel further submits that the investigation of the case FIR No. 243 dated 20.08.2021, under Section 306 of IPC, Police Station City Faridkot is being carried out in a transparent and fair manner.
3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is accordingly, disposed of.
