The instant writ petition has been filed for seeking issuance of a direction to the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner as per the Haryana State Litigation Policy and a further direction is prayed for against the respondents to release the pending payment regarding the work executed by the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a registered contractor with the Haryana Government and

MSME. It is contended that the petitioner had executed various works as mentioned in para 5 of the writ petition, however, the payment qua the said works has not been released to the petitioner despite repeated reminders.

She further submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.3-the Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra, to decide the representation dated 29.02.2024 (Annexure P-9) sent by the petitioner by passing a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vivek Saini, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-the Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra, to decide the representation dated 29.02.2024 (Annexure P-9) sent by the petitioner and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner being established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of three months.
