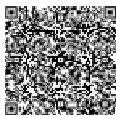

1. Prayer in the present application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, preferred by the petitioner-wife, is for transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, filed by the respondent-husband, registered as HMA/400/2023, pending before the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, SAS Nagar, Camp at Kharar, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was summoned in the above captioned case to appear in person on 08.05.2024 but the petitioner failed to do so. He further submits that as per case status available on the eCourts Services Web Portal, the above captioned matter is posted to 04.09.2024 for petitioner's evidence.

3. It is apparent from the above that for default in appearance in compliance of the notice issued, the petitioner has been proceeded against



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ex parte.
