KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The petitioner being aggrieved by the order dated 28.04.2023 (Annexure P-12) passed by the competent authority whereby the request made by the petitioner seeking eight weeks' parole was declined.

2. The State counsel submits that the aforesaid impugned order was passed about 1 year and 6 months back and that the present petition be disposed of with liberty to petitioner to file fresh application which will be considered and decided by the competent authority in a given time frame.

3. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh application seeking eight weeks' parole.



4. In light of the above, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh application seeking parole for a particular period and the same is to be decided by the competent authority within a period of 8 weeks of its filing in accordance with law, without being swayed by the observations if any made by the competent authority in its earlier order dated 28.04.2023 (Annexure P-12).

5. However, any observation made hereinabove is not to be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
