The application for placing on record the zimni order in compliance of the order dated 15.05.2024 (Annexure P-5), is allowed as prayed for subject to all just exceptions. The same is taken on record.

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The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners being accused had moved an application dated 16.11.2021 for re-medical examination of the complainant prior to the committal of the case. The said fact finds mention in the zimni order dated 07.04.2022. Thereafter, a reply to the application dated 16.11.2021 was submitted as is apparent from the zimni order dated 23.05.2022. Arguments were ordered to be heard on the application filed vide zimni order 10.03.2023. Despite the said order, the application was never decided. On account of the said fact, the

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petitioners moved multiple applications to decide the application dated 16.11.2021 and the last one was moved on 07.02.2024 (Annexure P-4).
