Prayer in the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of interim bail to the petitioner for 15 days in case FIR No.143 dated 25.08.2021, registered under Sections 21(c) and 25 of the NDPS Act, Police Station Special Task Force, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of the paper-book be handed over to him during the course of the day.

Learned State counsel was directed to get necessary instructions and information *qua* the genuineness of the prayer made in the instant petition in which it has been mentioned that brother of the petitioner has expired on 04.05.2024 and his bhog ceremony is to be held on 13.05.2024.

Learned State counsel during the course of instructions from

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brother of the petitioner will be performed on 11.05.2024 onwards and this schedule to be concluded on 13.05.2024.

Considering the aforesaid prayer to be bona fide, this Court has no reason to decline the justified prayer made in the instant petition, the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar, positively today itself.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Superintendent concerned on 14.05.2024 before 5.00 pm.

The present petition is disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
