1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the officials respondents to protect the petitioners from any false implication at the behest of the private respondents as the private respondents who are the married daughter and her alleged live-in partner have threatened the petitioners with dire consequences and false implication as the petitioners had taken action against private respondent No.5 and his relatives when the petitioners had approached the Court of Illaqa Magistrate, Amritsar. Further prayer has been made for taking appropriate action against the private respondents keeping in view the peculiar facts circumstances of the case.
2. Notice was issued to the State and in pursuance to the same, short reply by way of affidavit of Jaspal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Majitha, Amritsar (Rural) has been filed in Court, which is taken on record.
3. Learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to the reply filed and has submitted that the petitioners have refused to record their statements, but made oral submission before ASI Jagdeep Singh that

they have cordial relationship with respondents No.4 and 5 and they do not want any action against them. In the aforesaid affidavit, the deponent has also undertaken that no coercive action will be taken against the petitioners without providing them a reasonable opportunity of hearing and seeking their explanation. Learned State counsel has further submitted that in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of as such.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
