KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner No.2 an unmarried boy aged about 19 years is into live in relationship with petitioner No.1 an unmarried girl aged more than 18 years against the wishes of respondents No.5 and 6 who are parents of petitioner No.1.
2. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that aforesaid private respondents No.5 & 6 have threatened to cause harm to both the petitioners and in this regard, representation 26.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) was given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authority in this regard.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

5. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar to consider representation dated 26.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

6. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.5 and 6 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
