1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to proceed in accordance with law on the report (Annexure P-3) submitted by the Incharge, Economic Offences Wing, Jalandhar and register a criminal case against the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel inter alia submits that despite report (Annexure P-3) recommending registration of an FIR against respondent No.5, the official respondents had not initiated any steps in the said direction. After arguing for some time, learned counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to the official respondents to take appropriate steps in accordance with the provisions of law in view of the recommendations given in report (Annexure P-3).

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.



4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, Dy. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

5. In the wake of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the petition is disposed of and respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar is directed to look into his grievance and take appropriate steps, if any required, under the provisions of law. However, if respondent No.2 does not find the commission of any cognizable offence as alleged or any substance in the recommendations given in the report (Annexure P-3), then the petitioner shall be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by the Supreme Court in *Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh & Ors.* 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.
