The grievance of the petitioners is that they had made a complaint bearing No.65 dated 29.02.2024 against respondent No.5 – Maninder Singh Sachdeva, which is pending before respondent No.4 – ACP Licensing and Security. Another complaint made by said respondent No.5 – Maninder Singh Sachdeva, bearing No.35 dated 31.01.2024 is also pending before the said authority.

Learned counsel contends that respondent No.5 is the Advocate by profession and by taking the President and other office bearers of the Bar Association, Jalandhar, he is putting pressure upon the ACP concerned before whom the inquiry is pending. Learned counsel also submits that petitioner had made representation to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (Annexure P.2) and also to DGP, Punjab (Annexure P.3) in this regard but no action has been taken thereon.

Prayer is made by learned counsel to direct the DGP, Punjab so as to transfer the inquiries of both the parties to some place outside District Jalandhar.
