1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10, who are averse to their live in relationship.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1, aged about 21 years and petitioner No.2 aged about 20 years, are living in a live in relationship, however, the private respondents who are immediate family members of the petitioners, have not been able to accept their live in relationship as a result of which they have been continuously extending threats of dire consequences to them. Resultantly, a representation dated 08.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) was also made to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Hisar, for protection of their life and liberty, however, in vain. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police,



Hisar to look into their representation dated 08.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. On asking of the Court, Ms. Trishanjali Sharma, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
- 5. Learned State counsel submits that an FIR with respect to the missing of petitioner No.1 stands registered though not against petitioner No.2 but against unknown persons.
- 6. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Hisar to look into the representation dated 08.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) *qua* the alleged threat perception and take necessary steps, as may be required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents. However, this direction will have no effect on any civil or criminal action, which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
