1. On 15.05.2024, the following order was passed:-

“Prayer in this application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, preferred by the petitioner-wife is for transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short ‘the Act’), filed by the respondent-husband, registered as HMA/120/2024, pending before the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Faridabad, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Rewari, Camp at Kosli.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the notice received in the above captioned matter, the petitioner-wife has put in appearance on 08.05.2024 and the matter stands deferred to 12.08.2024. The petitioner has also filed a petition under Section 13(1) (ia)(ib) of the Act, which is pending before the Family Court, Rewari, Camp at Kosli. The Courts at Faridabad are at a distance about 75 kms from the residence of the petitioner. The petitioner being 20 years of age is handicapped to travel alone to attend the Court proceedings at Faridabad.

Notice of motion for final disposal, returnable for 28.08.2024.

On the oral prayer, liberty is granted to additionally serve the respondent through the counsel representing him before the Family Court.

Reply, if any, be filed before the date fixed with a copy in advance to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In the meanwhile, Family Court is directed to defer the



proceedings to a date beyond the one fixed before this Court.”

2. As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served through his father, however, he remains unrepresented.
3. For the reasons, noted in the order dated 15.05.2024, the application is allowed and the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, in HMA/120/2024, presently pending before the Family Court, Faridabad is transferred to the Family Court, Rewari, Camp at Kosli.
4. The Transferor Court is directed to remit the file to the transferee Court forthwith, after intimating learned counsel representing the respondent-husband for appearing before the transferee Court on 04.10.2024.

The application stands allowed.
