1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 11.08.2016 (Annexure P-7) vide which the request of the petitioner for grant of benefit of first ACP has been declined with a further prayer to set aside the order dated 13.01.2023 (Annexure P-8) vide which again the request of the petitioner has been declined by passing a totally non-speaking order in violation of the Scheme.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a legal notice dated 21.07.2023 (Annexure P-9) to the respondents but the same has not been considered and decided till date. She further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the aforesaid legal

notice dated 21.07.2023 (Annexure P-9) is considered and decided by the respondents in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Samarth Sagar, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, he has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 21.07.2023 (Annexure P-9) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
