1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to take legal action on the representation dated 04.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) and to register the FIR against respondent No.6, as he, by making fake Instagram pages and posting morphed and wrong pictures to lower down image of daughter of the petitioner, threatened, harassed and humiliated her and ruined her matrimonial life.
2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Nahar Singh, at the outset, submits that nothing survives in the present petition, as grievance raised



by the petitioner has been substantially redressed. In compliance of the order dated 14.05.2024, he has produced on record status report by way of affidavit of Harpal Singh Grewal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Special Crime), Moga, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5, in the Court today and the same is taken on record and perusal of its para No.6 indicates that FIR No.99 dated 17.05.2024 under Sections 354-C & 509 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 67(A) & 66(C) of the Information and Technology Act, 2000 has been registered at Police Station City Moga against respondent No.6 Bhupinder Singh.

3. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
