Prayer in the present petition is for seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to act upon the orders dated 18.04.2017, 08.08.2018 and 25.10.2018 (Annexures P-1 to P-3 respectively) passed by the Haryana State Pollution Control Board for closure of the unit of the private respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that since the premises of respondent No.1 Unit has already been shut down, therefore, this petition has become infructuous.

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Learned counsel for the respondents do not dispute the same.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 also submits that respondent No.1-Unit is shifting out from the residential area and relocating itself to an authorized zone.
