1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside/quashing the order dated 04.05.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.1.
2. As per report of the Registry, although, respondent No.2 has been served but however, no one has appeared on behalf of respondent No.2.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are residing in the house in question and at this stage, neither respondent No.2 has initiated any proceedings to execute the impugned order nor asking the petitioner to leave the house and thus, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage but liberty be granted to the petitioners to revive the same in case any cause survives to them.
4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, at this stage, with liberty aforesaid.
