The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take action against respondents No. 4 and 6 to conduct faire and impartial investigation in FIR No. 26 dated 05.03.2022 under Sections 379, 447, 427 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Kotakpura, District Faridkot expeditiously and in accordance with law.
2. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh submits that in the present case, appropriate legal action has also been taken against respondents No. 4 and 5. However, respondent No. 6 has been declared to be innocent in the present case. Learned State counsel further submits that the final report of investigation shall be presented within a period of 04 weeks from today.
3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is accordingly disposed off.
