JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.

The prayer in the present criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner which is in danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Notice of motion was issued on 16.05.2024, pursuant to which the statements of respondents No.4 to 6, who happen to be the parents and cousin of the petitioner-Anu Bala, have been recorded wherein they have stated that they have no intention to interfere in the life of the petitioner and she is free to live her life in the manner she thinks fit.

In view of the statements of respondents No.4 to 6, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

However, in case, the petitioner faces any threat in future, she is free to approach the investigating agency which shall take action in accordance with law.
