Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be permitted to withdraw the petition to enable the petitioners to again approach the competent authority qua their concerns/grievances. And, per their knowledge, even a ‘One Time Settlement Scheme’ has also been floated by the Government to settle the disputes.

In response, learned counsel for the respondent-HSVP submits that as per his instructions, no such Scheme has yet formally been launched. However, if the petitioners move the competent authority, it goes without saying that it shall deal with their concerns/grievances, and pass necessary orders, in accordance with law.
