DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

1. Learned senior counsel appearing for the appellant submits that he has express instructions from the appellant to withdraw the instant appeal to enable the appellant to avail of her remedy to seek custody of her child through filing an appropriate application under the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 (for short, the Act).
2. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
3. In case an application, the liberty of which has been sought and got through the instant order, is made by the appellant under the Act, the same shall be finally disposed of expeditiously by the trial court but not later than six months from the date of its filing. However, the application to be filed by the appellant for interim relief shall be disposed of within two months of its filing.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents agree to co-operate with the afore timeline and in furtherance thereof undertake to appear before the trial court on the date of the filing of the application by the appellant seeking therein custody of her child in case they are given due prior intimation by her.
