Keeping in view the fact that the Learned Single Judge has already observed so, we are of the view that the request of the counsel for the appellant to withdraw the present appeal would be justified, in the facts and circumstances as no prejudice would be caused to him if he would apply afresh and the exercise of verification of the antecedents of the appellant by the verifying authority(s) would have to be conducted since it is the case of the appellant that he has no criminal antecedents or never used the weapon wrongly.

7. Accordingly, the present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn, with the afore-stated liberty.
