This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.42, dated 17.03.2022 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga, with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 21.03.2022 (Annexure P-2).

As per report received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Moga, the parties could not appear before the trial Court to get the statements recorded, as was ordered by this Court vide order dated 15.02.2024.

Today, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners in Court.

Same was the situation on the previous date of hearing i.e. 02.04.2024.

As per office note received on the file, learned counsel for the petitioners Mr. Yagyaang Ajay, Advocate was informed but again the petitioners are unrepresented before this Court.

In the light of above, I am of the considered view that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition any further.

Hence, dismissed for non-prosecution.
