This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.PC for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 to take appropriate action in case FIR (Annexure P-1). The details of the FIR are as under: -

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that on account of injuries sustained by the petitioner in the occurrence, he got registered the aforesaid FIR (Annexure P-1). He contends that although the police had arrested one of the accused, namely Satnam Singh @



Satta but no efforts had been made by the police to take action against the accused in the occurrence, despite repeated requests, wherein the petitioner and his uncle received multiple injuries. Hence, the aforesaid FIR in question was registered under Section 307 IPC. He further contends that even a representation dated 03.04.2024 (Annexure P-7) was moved to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar, Punjab, but no action has been taken on the said representation and even a reminder dated 04.05.2024 (Annexure P-8) was also moved but despite that the concerned authorities are not taking any action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation(s) in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and, on instructions from ASI Subhash Chander, submits that the aforesaid representation coupled with the reminder shall be considered and dealt with in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

7. In view of the aforesaid submissions and the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3- the Sr.



Superintendent of Police, Ropar, Punjab, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 03.04.2024 (Annexure P-7) coupled with the reminder dated 04.05.2024 (Annexure P-8), to dispose of the same expeditiously by giving an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

- 8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
- 9. Disposed of.
