1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 an unmarried female aged about 18 years is into live in relationship with petitioner No.2 an unmarried male aged about 20 years and the said relationship is being opposed by respondents No.4 to 8 and in this regard, representation dated 09.05.2024 Annexure P-3 is already given to respondent No.2 but the police failed to take any action.

2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that aforesaid private respondents No.4 to 8 have threatened to cause harm to both the petitioners and in this regard, representation 07.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) was given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ambala but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authority in this regard.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the

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matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

5. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ambala to consider representation dated 07.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

6. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 8 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
