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On 23.08.2022, on behalf of the appellants statement (separately recorded), was made by learned counsel for the appellant to accept Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Fifty Thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the MACT concerned, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Upon apprehension of the DTC that the present appeal has already been disposed of on 06.10.2015 by Justice Lisa Gill, for which record was not available in the High Court, the matter was enquired into. Ultimately, it was found that the said appeal had not been disposed of on 06.10.2015 rather it is still pending with the Hon'ble High Court. This was also with reference to the report on an application moved by the DTC under the RTI.

After this, adjournments have been requested to get concurrence from the appropriate authority with regard to said proposal.

Today, on behalf of the Delhi Transport Corporation concurrence has been given to the said proposal dated 23.08.2022.

Accordingly, Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Fifty Thousand only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Delhi Transport Corporation to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Fifty Thousand only) in the name of the appellant No.1-Anu Verma with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 31.05.2024 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellants'

counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Before parting with the order, this Forum would like to record the appreciation for the efforts made by Mr. Amit Kumar, Manager (Law) and Mr. Devender Singh, Depot Manager in getting this case settled.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
